# GENERAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CENTRAL TEXAS REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY

#### RESOLUTION NO. 09-21

#### ACM Component Sale to Harris County, Texas

WHEREAS, the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority ("CTRMA") was created pursuant to the request of Travis and Williamson Counties and in accordance with provisions of the Transportation Code and the petition and approval process established in 43 Tex. Admin. Code § 26.01, et. seq. (the "RMA Rules"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the CTRMA has been constituted in accordance with the Transportation Code and the RMA Rules; and

WHEREAS, the CTRMA opened its initial project, the 183A Toll Project, with both cash and transponder toll collection systems; and

WHEREAS, the CTRMA has transitioned to a fully cashless toll collection system in order to provide a more efficient process for its customers and the CTRMA, resulting in the CTRMA having surplus cash collection system components, including automated coin machines and components that are no longer needed by the CTRMA; and

WHEREAS, Harris County, Texas ("Harris County") and the CTRMA are authorized to enter into an agreement to contract to perform governmental functions and services, including the purchase of goods and services pursuant to and under the provisions of Tex. Government Code Ann. §791.001 et seq, also known as "The Interlocal Cooperation Act"; and

WHEREAS, in reliance on such Act, Harris County and the CTRMA desire to purchase and sell certain automated coin machine components and equipment deemed to be surplus equipment by the CTRMA and being more fully described on <a href="Attachment "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes (the "Equipment") for the consideration reflected on Attachment "A"; and</a>

WHEREAS, the conveyance of the Equipment to Harris County pursuant to an Interlocal Agreement is consistent with the Interlocal Cooperation Act and the CTRMA's Procurement Policies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors finds the sale of the Equipment to Harris County to be in the best interests of the CTRMA and approves the sale of the Equipment to Harris County for the consideration reflected on <u>Attachment "A"</u>; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the CTRMA Board of Directors authorizes the Executive Director to execute and deliver an Interlocal Agreement to Harris County in substantially the form as set forth in <a href="Attachment">Attachment "B"</a> hereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Interlocal Agreement does not create any further obligations on either Harris County or the CTRMA beyond the express terms thereof, and the execution of the Interlocal Agreement by the CTRMA is only for the purposes stated therein.

# INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR TOLL EQUIPMENT AND COMPONENTS

This Agreement is made on this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2009 between the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority, a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas and Harris County, Texas, a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas.

#### WITNESSETH

Whereas, Harris County and the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority are authorized to enter into an agreement to contract with eligible entities to perform governmental functions and services, including the purchase of goods and services pursuant to and under the provisions of Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §791.001 et seq (Vernon 1994 & Supp. 2003), also known as "The Interlocal Cooperation Act"; and

Whereas, in reliance on such Act, Harris County and the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority desire to purchase and sell automated coin machine components and equipment.

Now therefore, the parties hereto mutually agree to the following:

I.

The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority hereby agrees to sell to Harris County and Harris County agrees to purchase certain automated coin machine components and equipment, a description of which is attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all intents and purposes (the "Equipment")".</a>

II.

The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority, by execution of this Agreement, agrees to sell to Harris County the Equipment in its current "as-is" condition and shall deliver the Equipment to Harris County at a location within Harris County, Texas no later than thirty (30) days from the effective date of this Agreement. The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority shall forward an invoice to Harris County for the Equipment in an amount based upon the pricing detailed in <a href="Exhibit">Exhibit</a> "A". Harris County shall pay such amount as full consideration for the purchase of the Equipment.

Neither Harris County nor the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority shall assume any responsibility or liability to the other party for the Equipment, except for the responsibilities specified in this Agreement. Harris County's payment required by this Agreement shall be made from current, available revenues, as approved by the Harris County's Commissioners Court. Furthermore, both parties agree that no payment has been, or will be made to the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority for any services or functions required to be performed under this Agreement except for the payment of the purchase price as reflected in the above-referenced invoice. In obtaining the Equipment, Harris County has relied solely on its own inspections, investigations, and due diligence regarding the Equipment and Harris County acknowledges that the

Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority has made no representations or warranties expressed or implied with respect to the Equipment.

This Agreement shall terminate and be of no further force or effect after the Equipment is delivered and full payment is received by the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority.

III.

This Agreement shall take effect upon execution by the signatories and continue until terminated as provided herein. Furthermore this Agreement shall serve as each governmental body's commitment pertaining to Harris County's purchase of the Equipment referenced in Article I hereof. This Agreement has been properly authorized by the governing bodies of the parties hereto.
