Community Invited to Participate in 183 North Mobility Improvements *Meeting Rescheduled for February 18th*

(Austin, Texas) – The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority and the Texas Department of Transportation have rescheduled the 183 North Mobility Project Open House meeting for Tuesday, February 18th at Anderson High School from 5 pm – 8 p.m. The Mobility Authority and TxDOT are working with other local partners to determine the best alternatives for managing congestion, as well as improving transit reliability and emergency response times, along the eight-mile segment of US 183 between SH 45 North and MoPac. Open House attendees will have the opportunity to learn more about the study process, comment on mobility improvement alternatives and submit official comments. Project staff and consultants will be available to answer questions. No formal presentation will be given, and attendees are invited to come-and-go at their convenience.
