

Mobility Improvements on the Horizon for Bergstrom Expressway Community Invited to Review at Open House

(Austin, Texas) – The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority and the Texas Department of Transportation are hosting an Open House meeting for the Bergstrom Expressway Project on Thursday, Nov. 13, 2014 at the East Austin College Prep Gymnasium from 4 p.m. – 7 p.m. The Mobility Authority and TxDOT launched an environmental study in August 2011 to develop a reasonable and feasible approach to improving mobility in the US 183 South corridor from US 290 to SH 71.

Open House attendees will have the opportunity to learn more about the study process, proposed mobility improvements and context sensitive solutions. Context Sensitive Solutions is a planning approach that gives community members an opportunity to influence the project's design so that it will reflect the local community's cultural and historic values and aesthetic preferences.
