Community Workshop Scheduled to Discuss Vision for Corridor

(Austin, Texas) – The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority is studying the construction of a new, 7.2-mile expressway in the middle of US 183 from US 290 to SH 71 in east Austin. The proposed project, known as the Bergstrom Expressway, would serve as a gateway between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport and the City of Austin. To ensure the project reflects the culture and character of nearby neighborhoods, the Mobility Authority is holding the second of a series of open houses and workshops to gather public feedback on ideas for elements such as gateway concepts, bridge designs, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, lighting, public art and landscaping.
