## MoPac Closure Planned for Installation of Major Bicycle and Pedestrian Bridge has been Cancelled

(Austin, Texas) – The MoPac Improvement Project construction team has cancelled the planned installation of the final section of a 450-foot-long bicycle and pedestrian bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad tracks south of Duval Road. The installation was scheduled to take place between Sunday, June 14 at 8:00 p.m. and Monday, June 15 at 5:00 a.m., however, a heavy-duty crane required to complete the installation is not available. Previously announced lane closures on southbound MoPac between Parmer Lane and Braker Lane have been cancelled. The bridge is part of a shared use path that will run alongside the southbound MoPac frontage road from Parmer Lane to Capital of Texas Highway near the Arboretum.

A new date for the installation has not been scheduled.
