Revised Concepts for Proposed Oak Hill Parkway Available at June 17th Open House

(Austin, Texas) – The Texas Department of Transportation and the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority are hosting an Open House meeting for the Oak Hill Parkway Study on Tuesday, June 17, 2014 at Covington Middle School from 4 pm – 7 pm. Since the last Open House, mobility improvement concepts have been refined and narrowed. Attendees will have the opportunity to learn more about the process, weigh-in on mobility concepts and submit official comments. Project staff and consultants will be available to answer questions. No formal presentation will be given, and attendees are invited to come and go at their convenience.

For those unable to attend in-person, a Virtual Open House will be available online at the study website www.OakHillParkway.com and will provide the same information available during the Open House and the opportunity to submit comments. The Virtual Open House will be available from June 18 – June 27.
