Public Invited to Review SH 45SW Alternatives at December 10th Open House

(Austin, Texas) – The Texas Department of Transportation and the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority will host an open house meeting for the SH 45SW Environmental Study on Tuesday, December 10 at Bowie High School from 5 pm – 8 pm. Attendees will have the opportunity to learn more about the study process, comment on mobility improvement alternatives, review considerations for addressing environmental effects and submit official comments regarding mobility issues in southern Travis and northern Hays counties. The meeting is part of the ongoing public involvement process for this study, which is considering environmental impacts, constraints, the needs of drivers and concerns of surrounding neighbors. A final decision about whether or not to build the project is anticipated in early 2015. Project staff and consultants will be available to answer questions.
