Manor Expressway to Open with Community-Wide Celebration

(Austin, Texas) – The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority (Mobility Authority) will open the Manor Expressway 290 Toll Road on May 17 with a special "On the Road Again" community-wide celebration. Joining state and local officials will be Acting United States Deputy Secretary of Transportation Victor Mendez.

Traffic on 290 East between US 183 and SH 130 has increased by more than 78% since 1990, posing challenges for the quality of life and economic prosperity for area residents. The Manor Expressway will offer a controlled-access toll road to connect Manor and SH 130 to downtown, while maintaining non-tolled frontage roads. It is expected to bring new development and businesses and as many as 2,200 jobs to Eastern Travis County.

The event, which will take place on the toll road in front of Applied Materials between Giles Lane and Harris Branch Parkway, will feature a 5K fun run,

community festival, car show, ribbon-cutting ceremony and parade. The Manor Expressway will open to traffic later Saturday evening. To learn more about the event or to RSVP, go to mobilityauthority.com/290toll.
