Weekend Closure Could Lead to Traffic Delays At US 183/US 290 Interchange

(Austin, Texas) – Construction crews building the Manor Expressway flyover interchange will be closing US 183 and US 290 this weekend while they install steel bridge beams above the two roadways in northeast Austin. Contingent on weather, the closure will begin at 10:00 pm on Friday, February 10, 2012 and last until Monday, February 13, 2012 at 6:00 am.

During the closure, drivers will be detoured onto the frontage roads and could face delays. Drivers heading south on US 183 will exit at Cameron Road. Drivers heading north on US 183 will exit at Manor Road. Drivers will be required to pass through several signalized intersections before reentering US 183. A similar situation will occur on US 290. Drivers will be have to exit US 290 at US 183 and then pass through a series of traffic signals before re-entering US 290.

Anyone heading to Bergstrom International Airport is encouraged to leave early or use an alternate route. More than 20 police officers will be onsite to manage traffic signals and keep traffic moving as smoothly and safely as possible. Weather or other factors could lead to changes in the closure schedule.
