## **CTRMA Contacts DA's Office Regarding Complaint**

The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority ("CTRMA") has been in contact with the Public Integrity Unit of the Travis County District Attorney's Office and has learned they are conducting a preliminary inquiry based on complaints received regarding CTRMA. The CTRMA has pledged its full cooperation with this inquiry related to board member's property holdings and the development of the regional mobility plan, and will provide all information necessary to answer promptly. The D.A.'s Office also expressed an interest in resolving the matter as quickly as possible.

"Until we saw the news reports and proactively contacted the DA's office, we were not aware of the existence or nature of this inquiry," says Mike Heligenstein, CTRMA's executive director. "The CTRMA has been scrutinized by two audits, by Travis and Williamson County officials, by TxDOT, and by the financial community -- and has received clean reports and high marks. As a local entity made up of local volunteer board members and professionals, the CTRMA looks forward to fully cooperating with the District Attorney's office to receive another clean bill of health."
