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Manor Expressway Construction Calls For Temporary Closure of Cameron Road Exit on US 183

(Austin, TX) – Construction of the Manor Expressway direct flyover interchange at US 183 and US 290 will require the temporary closure of the northbound US 183 Cameron Road Exit beginning May 19, 2010. The Cameron Road exit is expected to reopen by September 2010. During the closure, drivers on northbound US 183 wishing to access Cameron Road are encouraged to use the US 290 exit as an alternative.

The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority broke ground on the Manor Expressway on Wednesday, March 10, 2010. Phase 1 of the project involves construction of a direct flyover interchange at US 183 and will include completion of a 1.4-mile stretch of the Manor Expressway between US 183 and Chimney Hill Boulevard. The existing US 290 will become a frontage road system that will remain non-tolled. Phase 1 is expected to open to traffic in 2012.

At full build, the Manor Expressway will be a 6.2-mile tolled expressway between US 183 and Parmer Lane. It will be constructed in an expanded median of the existing US 290 and will include three tolled lanes in each direction.
