
Austin History MONTOPOLIS MOSAIC

4 = Grey 5 = Orange 6 = Brown






I SPY WHEELS ON THE BUS






Walk This Way Pedestrian Bridge


This bridge gets pedestrians safely across the highway.





Trees play many important roles in keeping our environment clean and our community healthy so it's important to protect them!






Oaks trees are common in Central Texas. They can grow as high as 70 feet tall!


Solar panels are used to help power road technology such as lighting.
