



SUMMARY:

Due to the unprecedented growth in Cedar Park and Leander, and a growing number of drivers on the 183A Toll Road, the Mobility Authority is conducting an environmental study for the possible addition of a fourth lane in the center median of 183A Toll in each direction between RM 620 and Hero Way.

Proactive expansion of the existing corridor would allow for the 183A Toll Road to accommodate future traffic volumes and reduce anticipated traffic congestion for years to come.

FUNDING:

- Environmental Study Cost: \$2 Million

CORRIDOR HISTORY:

- 2007: 183A Toll Phase I between RM 620 and RM 1431 opened to traffic
- 2012: 183A Toll Phase II between RM 1431 and Hero Way opened to traffic
- 2021: 183A Phase III Project between Hero Way and north of SH 29 broke ground. Completion is anticipated in 2025
